

# June 13: New numbers for Crestview

Thanks to the 2010 voter-approved bond issue, Crestview Middle School is replacing its aged telephone and voicemail system with Voice over IP technology that includes 911 service.

Rockwood is implementing this new phone system in many Rockwood elementary and middle schools throughout the school year. This new phone system will provide the following benefits to our staff and community:

- **Improved system:** the aged phone systems that schools are currently using are updated, providing better phone service and connections
- **Emergency Responder:** the enhanced phone system improves service to emergency responders ~ keeping everyone in the communication loop

## How will it work?

Crestview has a new phone number: (636) 891-6950 that replaces the old number of (636) 207-2520

Please be sure to make note of the new number, and add it to the contact list in your phone.

Each of the school's offices, teachers and support staff will have his or her own five-digit extension.

During the school day, parents may call the main office number and reach our friendly office staff. As usual, they will answer your questions and assist with your requests for information.

After school, you can dial the main number and then the staff member's extension to leave a message. Staff members will return calls as soon as possible the next day.

## What happens if I call the old phone number?

During the first weeks of the new school year, the old phone number will automatically roll over to the new phone number. After this initial rollover, parents who call the old phone number will hear a recording. It will provide the new phone number, and ask them to please hang up and dial it.
