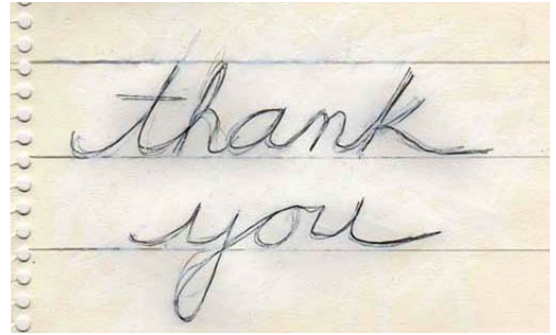

# *Kindergarten Enrollment*

*at Ellisville Elementary School*

*Wednesday, February 1st 9:30 AM—6:30 PM*

*Thursday, February 2nd 9:30 AM—3:00 PM*

Children must be five years old before 8/1/2012 to be eligible to begin kindergarten in the fall.

Rockwood offers full-day and half-day kindergarten programs to provide learning opportunities that benefit Rockwood students. To register for Half-day or Full-day kindergarten, parents must bring the following items:

1. [Household Census Information](#) (one per household)
2. [New Student Information Form](#) (one per student)
3. [Annual Student Health Form](#) (Must be submitted annually in order to provide proper care for the student.)
4. Birth Certificate issued by the Bureau of Vital Statistics.
5. Medically documented [Immunization/Health records](#) (This form can be submitted after the February kindergarten registration dates.)
6. Evidence of comprehensive vision exam performed by a state licensed optometrist or physician. Kindergarten and enrolling 1st grade students only. [Download the form](#) (This form can be submitted after the February kindergarten registration dates.)
7. Two forms of proof of parent/guardian residency. These documents should contain the parent/guardian's name and address. Examples of this could include: Deed/sales contract of residence, current real estate tax receipt, an unpaid utility bill (gas, water or electric) or contract to lease/rent.
8. Custody papers and a complete copy of the dissolution decree that stipulates custody in cases of parental divorce.
9. IEP and evaluation, if the student is receiving Special Education Services.
10. Emergency contact information.

To save time, feel free to download and fill out any of the above forms and bring them with you to registration.

IT IS **NOT** NECESSARY TO BRING YOUR CHILD WITH YOU TO REGISTRATION!

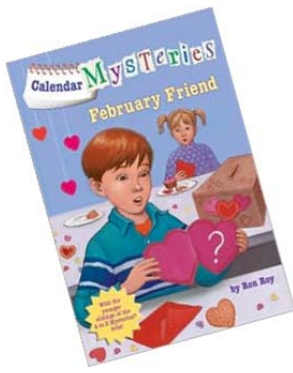

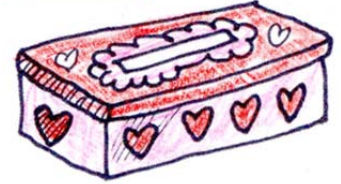

# Book & Breakfast Grades 1 – 3 February 15, 2012



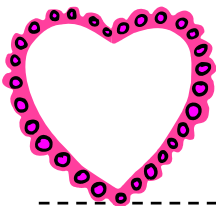
February's book is Calendar Mystery #2 February Friend by Ron Roy.

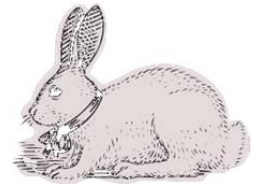
The meeting will be held on **Wednesday, February 15<sup>th</sup> at 8:15 A.M. in the cafeteria.**

## Read Around the Library Challenge Find the Treasure in Books



Each year in January, the library issues a Read Around the Library Challenge to the Ellisville students. The main focus of this event is to encourage recreational reading outside of the school day. This year our challenge uses the Rockwood Reading Week theme "Find The Treasure In Books." We are encouraging all students to read two books between January 23 and February 28, one should be fiction and one should be nonfiction. The books should be age, grade, and reading level appropriate. Students in grades K and 1 may count books that are read to them. After reading the books they have selected, students are asked to complete the attached form, have a parent sign it and return it to the library. Additional forms are available in the library, on the library website, or you may record the information on a sheet of paper.

In addition, this year we are asking parents to participate by telling us what their favorite children's book is. The form for this is also attached.

Our goal this year is to have at least 80% of our students participate and 20% of our parents. We have confidence that we can do it. Will you help?
