To be eligible for the celebration activity you must read all twelve of the nominees and

** complete one of the Mark Twain Nominee half sheet forms for each book

*** complete one of the activity options for each book on a separate sheet of paper

**** turn both pages in together for each book you read

Points to remember:

- Read the entire story
- Be specific, include details
- Use complete sentences – a minimum of five sentences is required
- Proofread your work for capital letters, punctuation, grammar, and quality answers
- You may only use each option two times

Option #1

Using complete sentences, describe what you feel is the most important or interesting part of the story.

Option #2

Explain the problem in the story and how it was resolved. Include details about the characters and the setting of the story.

Option #3

Using complete sentences and lots of details, describe what happens in the beginning, middle, and end of the story. Include information about the characters and the setting.

Option #4

Rate the story in Tiger Paws giving an explanation on why you rated the story the way you did.

Option #5

If you could trade places with one of the characters in the story who would it be and why.

Option #6

Using examples from the story, explain why the title the author selected fits the story.

Option #7

Design a poster that will convince someone else to read this story. Include written descriptions or textboxes. (No larger than 12" X 18")

Option #8

If you could change one part of the story, what would it be and why.
