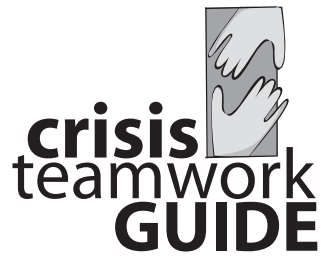

Prepare, Prevent, Respond

Rockwood is dedicated to safety awareness, prevention and crisis response.

Parents and community members are invited to join the Rockwood School District for an evening with Jesus Villahermosa, the founder of Crisis Reality Training, for a presentation focused specifically on school crises.

Date & Time: Tuesday, Oct. 19 at 7 p.m.

Focus: Parent/Community Awareness Training

For more than 25 years, Jesus Villahermosa has served on the Pierce County Sheriff's Department and S.W.A.T. team. He is currently a Sergeant serving as the supervisor of the Court Security Unit in Tacoma Washington. He was the first certified Master Defensive Tactics Instructor for law enforcement personnel in the state of Washington. Villahermosa's experience as a law enforcement officer has fueled his passion for people and their emotional, mental, and physical safety. His humor, real-life stories from the streets, and the practical application of the taught techniques guarantee a memorable presentation that transforms participants and offers real-life resources for crisis or vulnerable situations.

This presentation is part of a four-part series on crisis response sponsored by the Rockwood School District. Jesus Villahermosa will talk to high school students about how to stay safe on a college campus and he will talk to sixth-grade students about bullying and making safe choices to live drug and alcohol free. In addition, Villahermosa will lead discussions with Rockwood administrators on emergency planning and how the district would respond to a crisis at a Rockwood campus.
