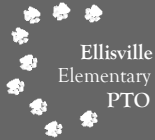

On Thursday, November 11th we will be having two assemblies commemorating Veteran's Day. Our 3rd through 5th graders will be honoring our Veteran's from 9:45-10:30 am and our kindergarten through 2nd graders from 11:00-11:45 am. Students will perform several patriotic tunes, as well as a military salute, to pay tribute to all veterans and our proud country. Our students are also collaboratively working to create a hallway display honoring our Veteran's.

We would like to cordially invite all veterans from any branch of the United States Military to attend and be recognized for their service. If you have a veteran able to attend, please complete the lower portion of the attached form and return it to your child's classroom teacher by November 5th so we are able to properly recognize them at the assembly. 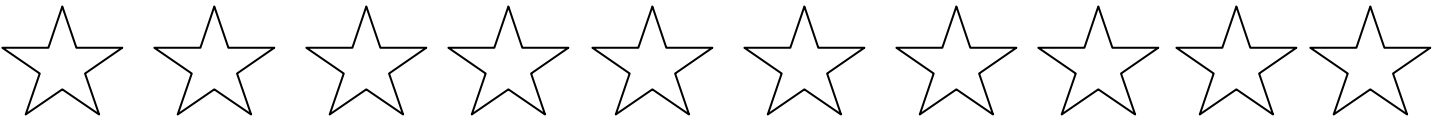
