# ACT Preparation at EHS

Today's students are finding the admission and scholarship process highly competitive. One of the most important student career factors could be acceptance to the university of choice.

Colleges use the scores from the American College Testing Program (ACT) to select applicants and award scholarship monies. Review courses, such as this one offered at Eureka High School, frequently help to increase scores, in part through diminishing test anxiety. While enrolling in a course does not automatically ensure higher test results, analyzing strategies to master reading comprehension, analogy exercises, writing samples and comprehensive math skills will often boost student confidence and scores.

During the first session, students take a pre-test using an official retired test to help identify their strengths and weaknesses. Each student will receive a report which includes an official score and areas where the student must focus his or her energy for maximum score improvement. This information is used by teachers of the program to help students improve on their areas of weakness. **Attendance at the first session is strongly encouraged.**
