INCOMING 6TH GRADE REGISTRATION INFORMATION AT LASALLE SPRINGS MIDDLE SCHOOL FOR CURRENT 5TH GRADERS

- On **Tuesday, January 10th at 7:00pm**, LSMS School Counselors will present information regarding 6th grade course options and instructions for registering online. Parents are encouraged to attend. If possible, we respectfully request that students do not attend this evening presentation as they will be viewing the same presentation during the school day at their elementary school. (*NOTE – the start time is different from the presentation for the current 6th grader and current 7th grader presentation*).
- On **Thursday, January 12th**, the LSMS counselors will present to students information regarding 6th grade course options and instructions for registering online. At this time, students will receive a copy of the Middle School Course Description Guide, online registration directions, and a Course Selection Sheet.
- **Between Friday, January 20st and Tuesday, January 31st**, students are expected to register online for their courses for the 2012-2013 school year. Students enrolling on the first or second day of the registration window will not receive a higher priority over those registering during the middle or end of the window. However, we do not advise waiting until the last weekend to register just in case there are technical difficulties.
- In addition to the online registration process, students will need to complete their Course Selection Sheet, have it signed by a parent, and return it to their 5th Grade Classroom teacher by **Wednesday, February 1st**. In the event there is a discrepancy between the courses marked on the Course Selection Sheet and the courses selected online, then the school will use the choices marked on the Course Selection Sheet.
- Please note that LaSalle will do its best to try and enroll students in the courses they have requested; *however*, there is no guarantee that a student will be enrolled in their first choice. Students who submit Course Selection Sheets after the due date will receive a lower priority for honoring that student's course requests.

- **Cost:** \$40 per player and this will include a mouth piece. In order to keep the cost down we will not purchase team jerseys. The team will decide on a common color to wear at each game.
- **How to sign up:** Players that are in 1st-6th grade can sign up as an individual or as a team. If you sign up as an individual, we will do our best to put you on a team that includes players from your school, but this is something that we can not promise.
- **TEAM REGISTRATION:** Keep your team to a limit of 10 and we could possibly add players to your team in order to keep a balance within the league.
- This is a non-competitive league. We will not keep a record of wins or losses and we do not have playoffs.
- As we all know the weather may not cooperate during this time of the year so we will begin on Saturday, March 3RD-4TH and March 10th-11th.
- In case of a rainout, we have the fields scheduled for Saturday, March 31st and Sunday, April 1st as make up dates.
- In an attempt to avoid conflicts with baseball season, we will play the entire league in 2 weekends.
