Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education **Distinction in Performance** Criteria for 2010. K-12 School Districts must meet at least thirteen out of fourteen performance standards, including all six MAP standards.

AdvancEd: The world's largest education community represents private and public school districts in 30 states and 65 countries. In April 2006, the North Central Association Commission on Accreditation and School Improvement (NCA CASI), the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Council on Accreditation and School Improvement (SACS CASI), and the National Study of School Evaluation (NSSE) came together to form one strong and unified organization under the name AdvancED.

MAP: The Missouri Assessment Program (MAP) is used to identify the knowledge, skills, and competencies that Missouri students should acquire by the time they complete high school and to evaluate student progress toward those academic standards.

ACT: The American College Test assesses high school students' general educational development and their ability to complete college-level work.

Advanced Placement Tests: Each year, NEWSWEEK selects the best high schools in the country based on the number of AP tests taken, divided by the number of students graduating that year.
