1. Students will read and analyze reading material.

Students will use effective reading strategies to better their understanding (make connections, determine main idea).

Students will analyze and evaluate story elements (setting, characters, conflict).

2. Students will use a variety of strategies to determine the meaning of new words.

Students will use decoding strategies and context clues to unlock familiar words.

3. Students will use the writing process to create a cohesive sentence.

Students will write a complete sentence using capitalization, subject, verb and end punctuation.

Students will write simple and compound sentences.

4. Students will use speaking and listening skills to improve communication.

Students will demonstrate appropriate speaking skills (eye contact, volume, tone of voice, body language and expression).

Students will use active listening behaviors (asks questions of speaker and used body language and facial expressions to indicate agreement, disagreement or confusion).
