Principal's Message

Dear LaSalle Families,

Spring is here! Hard to believe, isn't it? This past winter, more than others in recent years has certainly been very wintery. Now with the beginning of Spring, comes a time of growth and renewal...a time of new beginnings. It's a chance of us to take stock of where we are, and set goals for the future.

Spring also marks the time of year that our students are challenged to demonstrate their knowledge on state wide assessments. Public schools across the state are administering the annual state assessment, the Missouri Assessment Program (MAP). In sixth and seventh grades, our students will be testing in the areas of communication arts and mathematics, and eighth graders will test in these same subjects in addition to science. While there has been a great deal of discussion in classrooms recently about the MAP, the fact is that we have been preparing all year long. Teachers' lesson plans and school district curricula are aligned to state standards and grade level expectations. Teachers have used MAP like questions, such as constructed response, in their assessment of student performance, and have used these assessments to monitor student's progress.

Parents play an important role in MAP testing as well. Your support in making sure that your child has a good breakfast, is on time to school, has a good night's sleep, and is prepared for testing by dressing comfortably and having necessary supplies. (#2 pencils) Also, ask your child questions about the test, which conveys your interest and emphasizes the importance.

I am confident in our students' abilities and staff's dedication to continuous improvement for every student. Thank you for assuring that your child is committed to offering his/her personal best every day!

NURSE'S NOTES



Medications: The end of the school year is rapidly approaching! In keeping with the Rockwood School District Medication Policy, medications remaining at the end of the school year are to be picked up from the nurse by a parent, or an adult designated by the parent. No oral medication may be sent home with the student. *Asthma inhalers can be sent with a student only if I have a physician-signed "self carry" waiver on file.*

Any medication not picked up by the end of the last school day will be discarded. There are no exceptions—I cannot send unused medications home with any student, nor can they be sent by mail. Medication arrangements must be renewed yearly.

8th grade immunization requirements: Remember, students entering 8th grade next year are required to have a Tdap booster. If you received a letter about this, please call and let me know your child's status before school is out.

Underage Drinking: Spring is an important time for Rockwood parents and staff to combat the disturbing incidence of underage drinking in our communities. If you believe this issue does not concern your child, please think again. The research clearly shows that eventually, most of our kids will be faced with difficult and dangerous choices involving illegal alcohol consumption.

Keep this basic truth in mind: *providing alcohol* for teen consumption, or *passively allowing access* in your home, is against the law.

Parents often express frustration in not knowing how to handle what you know. Here's what you can and *should* do:

- Notify our LSMS School Resource Officer, Dan Smythe, at 636-733-4206. He can get the information to the appropriate police department for follow-up.
- Call the Safe Schools Hotline, 314-889-SAFE to give anonymous information.

Keep talking to your kids, and make a clear commitment that you will not provide, tolerate, or ignore underage drinking.

Our kids are counting on us—let's not let them down!

**Our 2011 MAP testing window is
Wednesday, March 30 - Friday April 15**

Students will be grouped to test in the content areas, 6th – 8th grade Math, 6th – 8th grade Language Arts, and 8th Grade Science. We encourage students to get a good night's rest the day before testing and arrive to school on time.

If possible, please try to avoid absences or making appointments for your child during these dates and times, so they are able to complete the MAP with their content area teachers. We understand that some absences may be unavoidable. If necessary there are make-up times scheduled with counselors.

Testing will occur daily from 7:30 am —2:22 pm for all grades. Students will be tested during their Language Arts and Math classes. There will be no testing on Thursday, April 7 unless a make up test is needed.

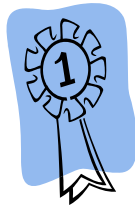

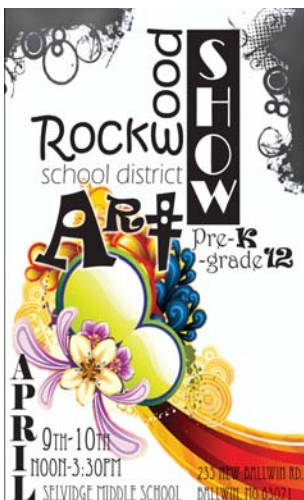
