The \$55 million, no-tax increase bond issue focuses on these five areas:

- **A**dditions for classrooms

At Stanton Elementary, funds from the bond issue will allow the district to:

- Replace aged classrooms computers and install additional classroom computers to lower the student-to-computer ratio
- Provide portable computers for full-time teachers to improve access to technology resources

- Provide student response systems (clickers) to facilitate immediate assessment of student learning
- Install amplification systems in designated areas, such as Art and Music
- Replace aged projection devices and/or interactive whiteboards (SMART Board™)
- Provide wireless coverage for all instructional areas
- Replace aged/at capacity telephone and voicemail system with Voice over IP technology that includes 911 service
- Replace aged network equipment and add additional switches
- Renovate restrooms
